






Cleaner Heat, Lower Bills: How Con Ed’s ‘Electric Advantage’ program demonstrates savings to individual customers and all ratepayers

Con Ed is currently exploring 132 NPA (Non-gas Pipeline Alternative) projects that operate similarly to the NPA discussed in this [video](#). In fact, every gas utility in New York has similar NPA programs. **Utilities need NY HEAT to enable successful implementation at a larger scale, so more New Yorkers can benefit and more ratepayer money can be saved.**

A March 2025 Benefit Cost Analysis prepared by Con Ed explains that their 24 new proposed projects would save ratepayers **\$2,123,369 compared to the gas infrastructure alternative**

Customers would receive, at NO COST, services including but not limited to:

Space heating and domestic hot water electrification	
All-electric appliances like stoves and dryers	
Weatherization and other building energy efficiency improvements	
Electrical upgrades to accommodate additional load from the new equipment	
Support from a contractor to provide end-to-end customer support for sales, design, installation, and operational education.	

With all of this provided at NO COST to the customer, these additional 24 projects would save ratepayers \$2,123,369 when compared to just replacing aging gas pipelines with no in-the-home upgrades.
